Family Agreement

V3 TUCSON, INC. is dedicated to supporting each of its residents in the pursuit of a truly sober and meaningful life. Within this unique private residential community all are coached in the areas of the 12-steps, life skills, work ethic and social skills. While personal recovery is ultimately the resident’s responsibility it is important that parents understand the depth of the disease and stand firm on the conditions made, and agreed to, upon admission at **V3 Tucson**.

As follows:

Admission Criteria – It is understood that upon admission, **V3** will ascertain whether the prospective resident is sufficiently detoxed for admission. In the event that the admitting resident is not, **V3** will require the family to provide immediate care for the individual at a medical detox facility. V3 assumes no responsibility, and is not responsible for arrangements for medical care prior to and/or during a confirmed admission/residency. Medical care is to be arranged directly by the resident and/or family. V3 Tucson is not a treatment center nor a medical facility and as such does not dispense medications as prescribed by the resident’s medical practitioner.

It is also understood that if the applicant is recalcitrant, refusing treatment and unwilling to participate in the program at anytime during admission and/or residency, **V3** reserves the right to immediately discharge the resident and assumes no responsibility for transportation or transfer arrangements.

V3 is a program that challenges and encourages young adults to become responsible for their recovery and behavior within the **V3** community creating a life of leadership, excellence and service. As such, V3 is not a licensed facility nor is required by Arizona law to hold a license for the services offered.

Recovery - Each parent is committed to supporting the resident at V3, and the V3 curriculum, for a period of 12 months (minimum). As such, the parent agrees to provide **V3** with a Tough Love letter that clearly states their support, expectation and commitment to boundaries set. Parents understand that to allow the resident to come home prematurely sabotages the resident’s recovery.

Communication – Residents must EARN the privilege to make phone calls home. Weekly parent phone calls may commence after 6 weeks post-registration (based on earned privilege). This is a privilege that may be withheld as the result of non-compliance. We ask that the parents immediately advise **V3** staff of any unauthorized email or phone calls from the resident. Parents may **not** send gifts at any time prior to the first Family Workshop Seminar, and must have approval from the V3 staff/point-person before sending birthday, Christmas, and/or Chanukah gifts during residency.

Alanon – In order to effectively impact the resident’s overall personal recovery it is important for families to participate in the process from the beginning. Regular attendance at Alanon is therefore strongly recommended for the parents, and mandatory for enrolment in the Family Workshop Seminar series. As a sober living community **V3** shares a common recovery language and a unified family support system that is learned through the practice of 12-step principles and regular attendance at 12-step meetings. This recovery language supports the family’s position.

Workshops – Family Workshop Seminars are offered to parents and are scheduled at 3 to 4 month intervals. It is vital that you are committed to attending all three workshops. The cost of these workshops is \$2,500.00 per workshop weekend. The entire experience can be absolutely transforming. **V3** is privy to miracles ongoingly – always creating opportunities for forgiveness, loving detachment and healing.

Visitation – As an earned privilege family visits are contingent upon the resident’s progress and contribution within the community. Family visits usually occur at approximately 3/4 months and align with the on-site Family Workshop Seminar Series. **V3** does not permit home visits during the 12 month residency program.

Voluntary Departure/Discharge – In the event of a voluntary departure and/or early discharge, resident will be given ample opportunity to collect all personal belongings. V3 is not responsible for any items left behind, and is not responsible for shipping or replacing such items.
